Snap Internet LTD Undergraduate Scholarship

The Snap Internet Scholarship in Computer Science and Information Technology was established by Snap Internet Limited in 2010. This scholarship has been endowed to undergraduate students to contribute to the completion of their degree with financial assistance.

1. The scholarship shall be known as the Snap Internet Limited Undergraduate Scholarship.
2. The Scholarship will be open to undergraduate students at the University of Canterbury studying a Computer Science or an equivalent Computer systems or Information Technology degree full-time.
3. One scholarship shall be offered each year to a New Zealand citizen or permanent resident.
4. The scholarship shall be valued at \$4000 and will contribute to living costs over two terms - \$2000 per term.
5. The Scholarship shall be awarded by a committee including the CEO of Snap Internet LTD and assisting staff, based on an application and an interview process.
6. The successful candidate will accept a position working at Snap Internet for at least two hours per week during the student year to gain work experience, with the exception of pre-agreed study weeks.
7. The successful applicant will also be offered free broadband for the study year.
8. If at any time, the Scholarship Committee is not satisfied that the candidate they have chosen is performing to the standard required or failing to comply with the terms and conditions, then the scholarship maybe withdrawn.
